# **Special Contributions Total**

(as a result of this fund-raising trip and report)

### \$55,657

in answer to a request for a Van - \$25k in answer to general work- \$23k in answer to helping with rent costs - \$6657.00 in answer to assistance to medical costs for Naomi - \$1000

Here is what we have done/are doing with special collections received:

- 1. We had a past due debt to the Native owners of the land the school occupies of \$10k. We paid that.
- 2. We had to pay a two-year rent payment, \$12k, upfront, in order to secure his family dwelling. Doka and the elders are working to move him and his family onto the school grounds within the next 2 years, in order that we can remove this recurring cost.
- 3. We wired \$1k for medical issues for Naomi when that money was received.
- 4. We've received a \$25k check. Doka and the elders will discuss how to best use this money for the purchase of a Van. We will try to stay well within this limit.

### **INCOMING each month**

Nine churches and 2-3 individuals support this work with regularity. The amount varies by 500-700 per month because one congregation does not offer an exact, repeatable, amount, which is absolutely fine, but it affects the figures a bit. The average coming in for each month is \$2900, which is up by \$500 per month, compared to 2017.

# **OUTGOING each month**

We do NOT send money each month because it costs us money (\$25) each wire, so we do this every other month. We are currently sending \$5k each wire, which works out to be \$2500 each month. Because we have ALREADY paid two years worth of rent, we do not include this figure into what is sent each month, but however you think about it, we are still paying it. So, if we add the rent cost (\$500 per month) to the existing wire (\$2500) then you arrive at \$3k per month.

So, this is how the budget breaks down, currently.

### \$3000 per month

#### Family fund \$1500 per month

• rent, food, medical costs (\$450 Hep C meds), children's education costs, contribution to the Lord's church, family transportation (new van will serve to reduce this cost for him)

#### Work fund \$1500 per month

• materials for adult Bible students, teacher salaries (12-14)

We have each of these budgets broken down more specifically. If you want to see those extended budgets, then contact us and we will happily provide everything to you.

- 3. Things have, and remain, more challenging in Nigeria than in years past. People are really afraid. It makes things difficult, but we would like to see the learning centers return some day. We would like to see more drip irrigation seminars, thanks to a good beginning from Healing Hands ministry.

God has blessed Doka's work. Your prayers have been heard. God is working. Let me say this in conclusion, when Doka returned, he baptized his mother! Because, and ONLY because, he missed his original flight (and we had to reschedule his arrival time), he was able to get an appointment with West Chicago, many years ago. Today, they remain deeply connected to this work. Because, and ONLY because, he missed his flight this year, he was able to get an appointment with the folks that led to his getting \$25k for a new van. These are NOT mistakes, nor mishaps. God blesses, especially when we don't think it possible. We praise God for all these, and you, because you are tied to this work with us. Thank you for you love shown in your continuing support.
